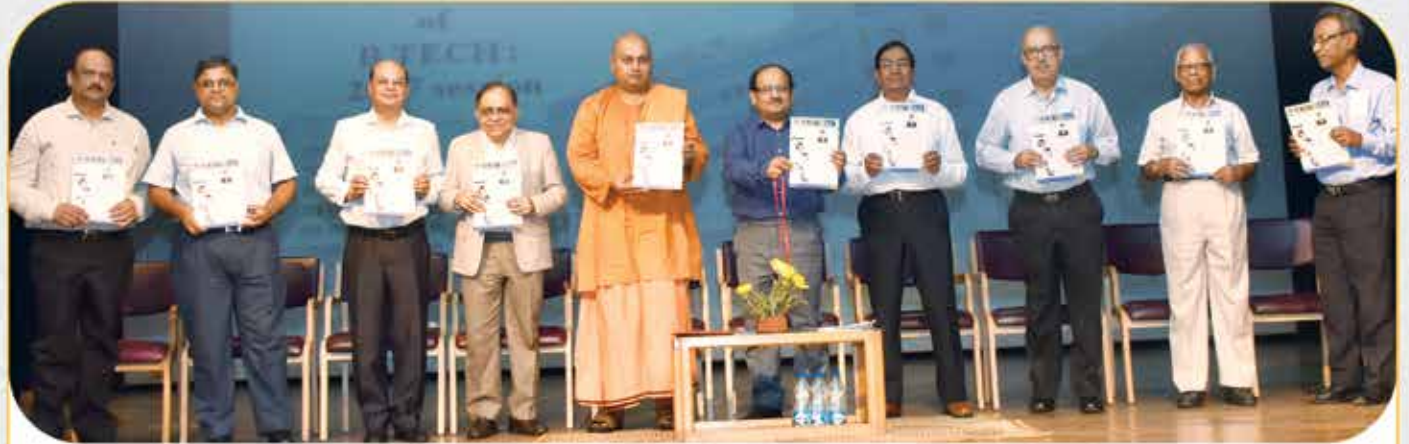
Career Fair 2017

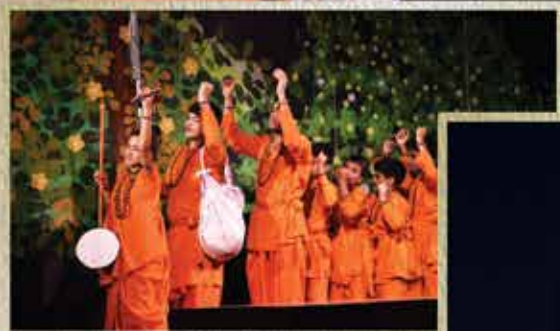
An interactive workshop against addiction and substance abuse in colleges was conducted by Actor & Activist, Mr. Bobby Chakraborty on 3rd August 2017.

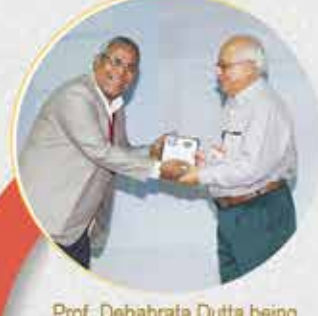
