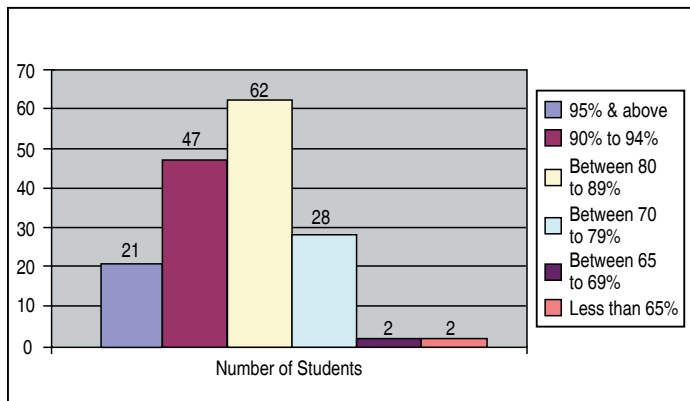

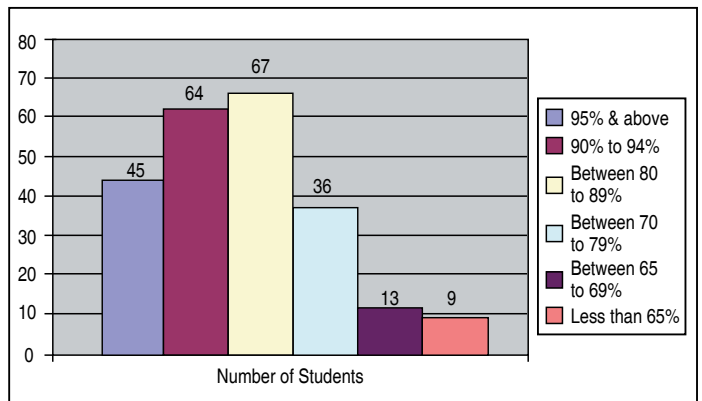

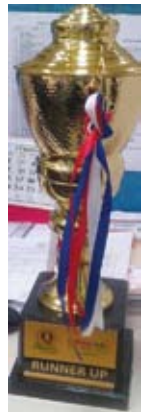

Six teams from six top city schools engaged in a heated war of words at The Heritage School on Monday morning. Bottle bulbs set to light up Sunderbans

Kolkata: Cramped shanties with holes for windows — as much as that even daytime looks like evening indoors. Worldwide, such difficult living conditions can be found not only across developing countries but also in pockets of developed countries. And of course, in Bengal. After Philippines, Kenya, Mexico, Egypt, Colombia and many more countries, the global campaign, 'Use of Light, has now come to Bengal, thanks to a group of city students.



HER students give a demonstration of the bulb. The filled bottle is then inserted into a metal stand, where a hole has been cut out already. This kit is then embedded in a shanty, with part of the bottle jutting out, and sets as a source of light.

Pradeep explained to the students how the 'bottle bulb' work by refraction: "The sun's rays hitting the bottle are refracted through water. The refracted light spreads at 90-degree in a room and produces light equivalent to a 50 watt bulb."

The use of plastic bottles, water and the sun to provide indoor lighting was developed by Santa's Alfredo Moser (19 years old) in 2009. He was a 12-year-old boy from a village in the Philippines. But this presents an obvious question — is there any inexpensive solution for night lighting as well? Pradeep answers: "We have also looked into this angle and have come up with a solution — a solar panel with an LED bulb. Depending on the bulk of orders, these can be bought for as little as \$100, which will run for five years. We have ordered a circuit assembly for beyond conventional lanterns available at our price. We have also added a new element to our recycling philosophy by making use of material waste to waterproof the stringing LED."

The solar panel is fixed on the mouth of the plastic bottle with the LED bulb glued into bottom. The wire is sealed off with glue and a switch is provided which is used to turn the light on or off. Only trouble is during the monsoon, when the sun hides behind clouds, this model will be ineffective only partially. Also, the battery loses its efficiency after 1.5 years and members of the community will have to be trained to service the night light and replace the battery. But the positive aspect of the drive is its extension towards parents. "The initiative doesn't believe in parents, said Pradeep.
