'POTTER MAGIC' AT HERITAGE BUSINESS SCHOOL

We all love to celebrate achievements, but the Heritage Business School (HBS) recently chose to focus on an equally important aspect of our work lives—overcoming negativity and facilitating skills at the workplace—through a workshop and panel discussion, in association with The Telegraph.

The day started with a welcome address by HBS chairman H.P. Budhia. First up was a workshop by Michael A. Potter, attended by the students of HBS and six other B-schools in the city.

Potter, a former English footballer with Bolton Wanderers FC and now an entrepreneur, trainer and consultant, started the workshop with, "I am not related to Harry Potter but I wish I had a magic wand to solve problems. But that would have also made my life boring and less challenging."

He divided the workshop into three sessions and four activities. The sessions covered communication skills, problem-

solving and decision-making, and developing effective workplace relationships with colleagues. The activities included testing communication skills, a logical puzzle to test your problem-solving skills, a personal SWOT analysis and ways to build your network.

In between his presentation, Potter narrated anecdotes that not only

entertained the audience but also served as real-life examples to explain his theories. With ample doses of humour and energetic interactions, he kept the students hooked through the day and also gave them tips to improve communication skills and emotional intelligence to become a better leader.

The workshop was followed by a panel discussion comprising Sujoy Banerjee of McNally Ebarat Engineering PE, Clusterjee of Birla Corporation, Shilpi Biswas of ABP Pvt Ltd, George Thomas of MSP Group and Subrato Banerjee of Anmol Feeds. Moderated by Madhurima Ganguly of HBS, the discussion touched upon the issue of negativity at the workplace and the possible reasons and factors that lead an individual to become negative and spread negativity among peers and subordinates. Three Kolkata institutes tie up for solar energy research

BUOYANT over the prospects of renewable energy, particularly solar energy, three of Kolkata's premier institutes of technology and management have joined hands to encourage, promote and conduct collaborative research and development activities on efficient solar cells development using state-of-the-art laboratory facilities.

The Indian Institute of Engineering Science & Technology, Shibpur (IEST), Centre of Excellence for Green Energy & Sensor System (CEGESS) and Heritage Institute of Technology, Kolkata (HITK), have also lined up plans to introduce specialised M.Tech course on 'renewable energy' at HITK. A MoU to this effect was signed here on Tuesday.



quent association will facilitate joint training and research activities by students and faculty members of the institute. The joint collaborative research projects, publications in journals, research and development activities on various types of solar cells such as organic and inorganic solar cells are significant components of this



association." P K Agarwal, chief executive officer (CEO), Heritage Group of Institutions, said.

The Narendra Modi government has set an ambitious target of 100 gw of installed solar energy by 2022. Industry officials think it may remain a pipe dream unless the industry and the government address the crucial issue of

shortage of efficient human resources.

Different studies in this regard suggest that India will require nearly one million full time efficient manpower to put up and manage this solar capacity.

The skills required in the sector will be in the form of manufacturing, engineering, design and drawing, business development, project development, installation and commissioning and operations and maintenance.

Besides, there will be opportunities for construction, civil work, supply chain and logistics, HR, finance, administration and general management. There is an immediate need for designing and developing specialised curriculum, at the same time carrying out research and development work, he said.

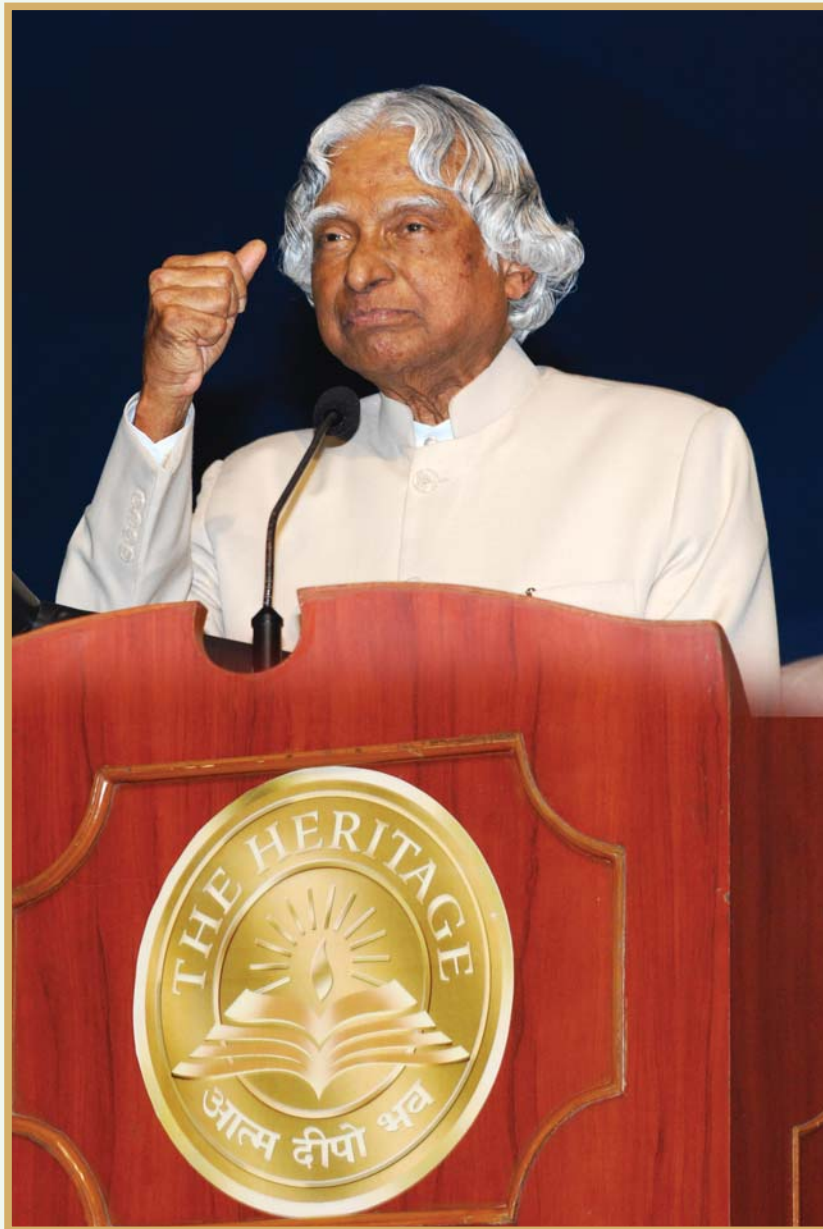
