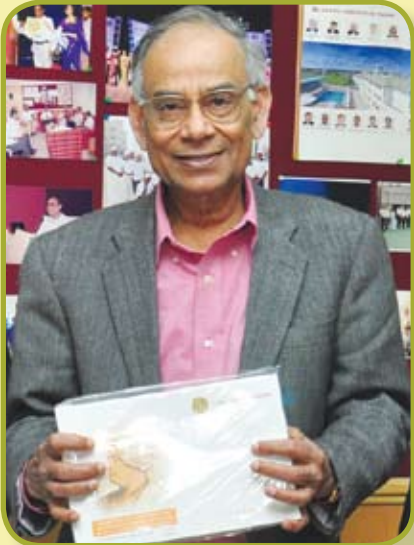

IIT call to entrepreneurs

An Entrepreneurship Awareness Camp at the Heritage Institute of Technology on Monday presented by the Entrepreneurship Cell (E-Cell) of IIT Kharagpur, in association with The Telegraph, urged youngsters to turn entrepreneurs rather than just job-seekers.

The camp was part of the Entrepreneurship Awareness Drive (EAD) launched by the IIT entrepreneurship cell in 20 cities across India since last month. More than 200 students and entrepreneurs attended the camp in Calcutta, the penultimate stop.

The speakers were Hari Balasubramanian, the founder and CMD of Ontrack Systems and founder of TSC Calcutta, Abhishek Rungta, the CEO and founder of IndusNet Technologies and co-founder of Seeders Venture, Divakar Choudhary, the co-founder and CEO of Musantra, and Anil Karwala, the managing director of Karwala Industries.

Entrepreneurship would not only lead to innovation, but it also would ease the pressure on the job market through local economic growth, the speakers said. They stressed the need for entrepreneurs to concentrate on ethical factors apart from highlighting possible risks that they ought to keep in mind.

"Half the world's population is surviving on Rs 100 a day and a population of 10 crore in the European is unemployed. Because of global pressure, competition in the Indian job market is not ethical and rather than becoming job-seekers, today's youth should focus on entrepreneurship, taking a crucial step towards career-building, not compromising on social responsibility at the cost of profits," Balasubramanian said.

Innovative business plans, out-of-the-box ideas and entrepreneurial skills, these and much more were the highlights of the AIESEC Youth to Business Forum 2012, held in association with The Telegraph on October 5 and 6. AIESEC is the world's largest student-driven organisation working towards global leadership.

The two-day meet also saw a business plan competition, where five city colleges took part. Each participating college — St. Xavier's College, Bhawanipur Education Society, JD Birla Institute of Management, IIPM and Heritage Institute of Technology — were assigned a mentor company. These companies, like Introssoft Technology Group, Anderson Printing House, O'Nergy and Bengal Shristi, helped the students come up with unique and sustainable business plans.

The business plan competition, held at GD Birla Sabhagar on day one, aimed at bringing out new ideas from young and aspiring entrepreneurs. Students showcased biz models ranging from the use of social media for the pharmaceutical industry to looking at the poultry farming industry from a fresh perspective.

The winners of the competition, Anirban Karmakar and Debopam Ghosh from the Heritage Institute of Technology, were given a chance

to display their business plan before the corporate leaders, apart from winning trophies and certificates.

"There are various challenges that we face as aspiring entrepreneurs. Many of us simply back off because of a lack of knowledge. There is also a huge misconception with regards to entrepreneurial ventures in West Bengal and we are trying to make students understand the risk factors," said Chirag Chhalani, president, AIESEC, Calcutta chapter.

According to assistant professor Anirban Pant from IIM Calcutta, who judged the competition, a lot of emphasis must be put on getting the ideas right first and being clear about one's goals before setting out on any such venture.

A panel discussion on the challenges faced by young entrepreneurs followed on day two at the Bengal Chamber of Commerce, where panellists answered questions put forward by young entrepreneurs.

"One must be ready to face objections from family members and to take up challenges. You may fail once or twice but if you are in the right direction, you must not hesitate in taking the plunge," said Sanjay Dwarika of Big 4 Consultancy, one of the panellists. Other panellists included Supriyo Sinha from the ABP Group and C.P. Singh of Praxis Business School. The discussion was moderated by B. Hari of The Indian Entrepreneurs (TIE).

Lee Kuan Yew, the Singaporean Prime Minister, has been named as one of the two greatest leaders of the 20th century in a poll conducted by the BBC. He was ranked alongside Mahatma Gandhi, who was named the greatest leader of the 20th century.

Lee Kuan Yew was the first non-white person to win the Nobel Peace Prize. He was awarded the prize in 1955 for his role in the founding of the Republic of Singapore.

Children from various schools in Calcutta met with scientists from the Indian Institute of Space Science and Technology (IIST) to discuss the challenges of space exploration and the role of science in our lives.

The scientists shared their experiences and insights into the world of space exploration, including the challenges of launching satellites and the importance of international cooperation in space research.

Internet emits 830 mn tonne of carbon dioxide

Internet and other technologies of information communication and technology industry (ICT) annually produces more than 830 million tonnes of carbon dioxide, the main greenhouse gas, and is expected to double by 2020, a new study has found.

Researchers from the Centre for Energy-Efficient Telecommunications (CET) and Bell Laboratories, the ICT products emit 1.2 per cent of global emissions — in the same proportion as the entire industry produces.

Dr Yuan Tseh Le, the Chinese physicist who won the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1956, has shared his story in a book titled 'My Story'. The book is a collection of his personal experiences and insights into the world of science and the challenges of being a scientist.

Dr Yuan Tseh Le was born in 1911 in Beijing, China. He studied at Tsinghua University and later at the University of Chicago. He was awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1956 for his work on the quantum theory of the electron.

Dr Yuan Tseh Le has been a leading figure in the field of quantum physics and has made significant contributions to the understanding of the electron and its interactions with light.
