Agenda No. 2: Review of the admission in UG and PG for the academic year 2020-2021

The Registrar provided detailed information about admission in the UG and PG programmes for the academic year 2020-2021. 940 students took admission in B Tech courses and 69 students in M Tech courses. Also 119 Lateral Entry students took admission in the B.Tech. courses.

In this context, Registrar urged the Dean to arrange special classes for Lateral entry students at the earliest.
