## Welcome by the Chairman

The Chairman welcomed all the members to the thirty-fourth meeting of the IQAC. The minutes of the thirty-third meeting of the IQAC held on May 31, 2024, were confirmed. The Chairman then requested the Coordinator to present the agenda items.

# Agenda No. 1: Formation of the External Peer Team for the Academic Session 2024-25

The Coordinator apprised the members about the importance of Academic and Administrative audit. The Coordinator reported that for the academic year 2022-23 departmental audit was done by most of the departments and IQAC also received the departmental audit report from some of the departments. The Chairman requested the HoDs (Head of the Department) to nominate two persons not below the rank of professor for the formation of External Peer Team for Academic and Administrative audit for 2023-24.

# Agenda No. 2: Review of the ongoing academic activities of the Institute

The Coordinator informed the members that the internal Hackathon, HackHeritage 2024 will take place on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of September and 183 teams had registered so far. There is a plan to select 100 teams for the final round of HackHeritage 2024.

The Coordinator also reported about the upcoming IEEE-IC: Standards Workshop and Hackathon to be organized by the IEEE India Council Industry Academia Young Professionals Committee (IAYPC) for 2024 in collaboration with India Internet Foundation. Heritage Institute of Technology has been chosen as the Nodal Centre in Eastern India. As a part of this initiative, a one day Workshop will be held at the institute premises on 24th September 2024.

The Coordinator apprised the members that Ministry of Railways (MoR) has signed a MoU (Memorandum of Understanding) with AICTE (All Indian Council for Technical Education) and from Heritage Institute of Technology, the departments of ECE (Electronics and

Communication Engg), EE (Electrical Engg.) and AEIE (Applied Electronics and

Instrumentation Engg.) will take part in it.

An alumni of the institute, Mr. Saptarshi Mitra of BMC Electroplast has extended his interest

in receiving consultancy from the institute for "Developing of Sensors and NFC for Electrical

Power Systems". He has already met with the faculty members of the departments of ECE and

EE.

The Coordinator also informed that HIT has signed an MoU with the Heartfulness Institute to

impart value education to the students based on humanitarian principles that will lead to the

creation of caring minds that can shape up a just and humane society.

The Controller of Examinations (CoE) apprised the members that as a reform measure in

examination system the question paper for semester examinations will be set wholly by the

external experts. To give continuous evaluation more impetus, there is a target for

implementation of 50-50 weightage to continual assessment and end semester examination.

The Coordinator reminded the members that from the next academic session Choice Based

Credit System has to be implemented, a requirement by University Grants Commission (UGC).

Agenda No. 3: Plan of Action for the Academic Session 2024-25

The following schedules for first year students were proposed by IQAC: Teaching ends on 20th

December, examinations to be held from 6th January to 15th January, and Mid Semester

Examination during the first week of December.

Agenda No. 4: Miscellaneous

The proposal for closure of the bank account of Student Council, which has been inactive for

a long duration, was placed before IQAC by the Coordinator. The proposal was unanimously

passed by the members of IQAC and it was resolved that upon closure, the amount lying in that

account to be transferred to the bank account of the Institute.

There being no other item on the agenda, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the

Chairman.
