

Agenda No. 5: Miscellaneous

Examination Pattern and Criteria for Obtaining an Honours Degree from the 2023–2024 Academic Session

The Controller of Examinations at HITK reminded members that as per the approval of the 38th Academic Council Meeting, examination pattern has been changed starting from the 2023–2024 academic session. Additionally, the Institute is going to implement criteria for obtaining an Honours degree applicable for students admitted in the 2023 academic year. The guidelines for obtaining an Honours degree have already been discussed and approved in the 36th Academic Council Meeting. Controller of Examinations of HITK briefly stated the salient features of these guidelines which are as follows:

- A student can opt for an Honours degree by satisfying the criteria defined in the guidelines.
- To be eligible for the award of a B.Tech. (Hons.) degree in the relevant discipline, a student must successfully acquire an additional 20 credits through courses earmarked for the

Mane of.

B.Tech. with Honours program with at least a 6.75 CGPA in those courses. Additionally, the student must successfully acquire 160 credits through courses earmarked for the regular B.Tech. program with at least a 7.5 DGPA and must pass all subjects on the first attempt. This is also applicable for lateral entry students.

 Of the additional 20 credits, 16 credits must be earned from NPTEL-SWAYAM platform. The remaining 4 credits must be earned through research, innovation or entrepreneurship activities.

There being no other item in the agenda, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
