The Heritage Students' Covid Relief Force was formed on May 5. The team has been providing verified leads for oxygen supply, hospital beds, testing, and even helping the needy with vaccine registration.

The Relief Force is an initiative by the institute's Students' Council in partnership with its alumni association.

It is primarily an online database of verified Covid-19 resource leads but also has students addressing requests through calls and messages received on social media. The core team has already recruited a total of 200 volunteers across all the departments of the college to help with the networking.

How the Relief Force works:

The team started off by sorting the volunteers based on their location and dividing them into zones. Volunteers are now spread across six zones -- east, west, north, south, central Kolkata, and Rest of West Bengal.

These zones have been subdivided into two teams -- the Requirements Team, and the Verification and Calling Team. The former addresses need-based requests and verifies people who approach them for help. The latter cross-checks leads and updates them to Google Sheets on an hourly basis.

The Verification team has been divided into shifts and it has been functioning all day except 2am to 7am. You can reach out to them on their **Facebook page**.

Aim and the road ahead:

"So many people are losing hope. When we see some of their posts or people call us for aid, our aim is to reach out to those in fear and uncertainty and help as many people as we can. We just wish to be there for those who are facing the worst onslaught of this crisis," said Ritwick Bakshi, a third-year student of Electronics and Communications at the Heritage Institute of Technology. He is one of the core team members.

It's very fulfilling to see that happen," said Shuvam Podder, a core team member and a fourth-year student of Electronics and Communications.














4. Do you use reusable water bottles, grocery bags and plastic alternatives when you can ?


