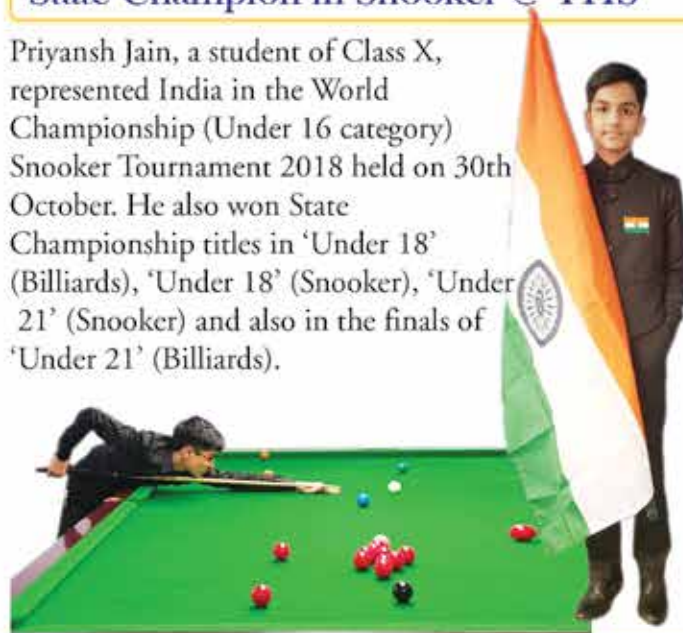
Badminton Champions @ THS

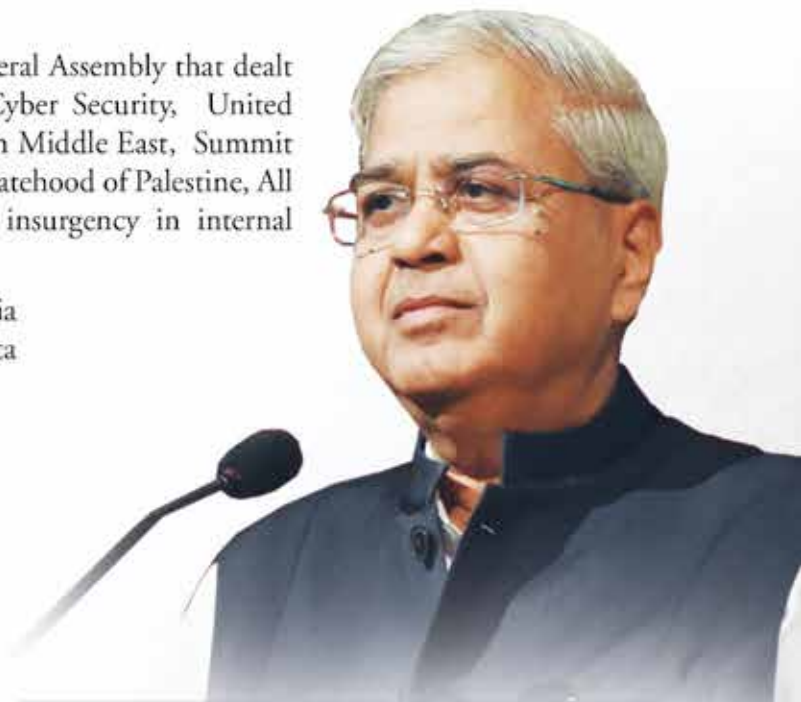
THS MUN 2018

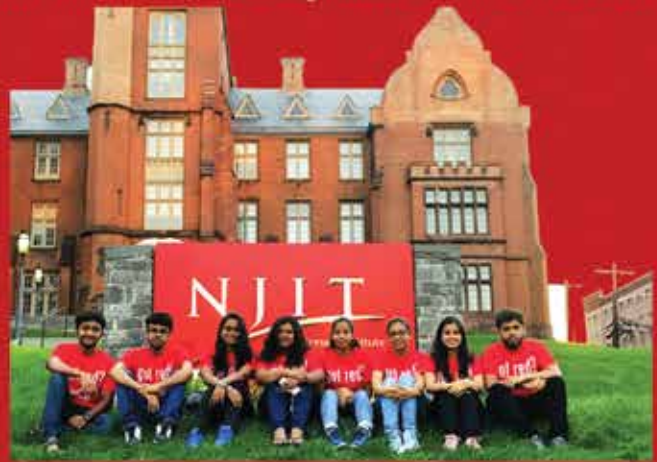

Greatcell Solar visit @ HITK

Dr. Enrico Leonardi also spent six days from 9th to 14th July, 2018 in the Renewable Energy Research Laboratory organized by Dr. Jayati Datta, Professor and Head, Dept. of Chemistry, HITK. There he demonstrated the operational procedures and disseminated the hands on skills to the research scholars. He installed several sophisticated equipment for fabrication and characterization of Dye Sensitised Solar Cells for attaining the prototype level in the Renewable Energy Laboratory. 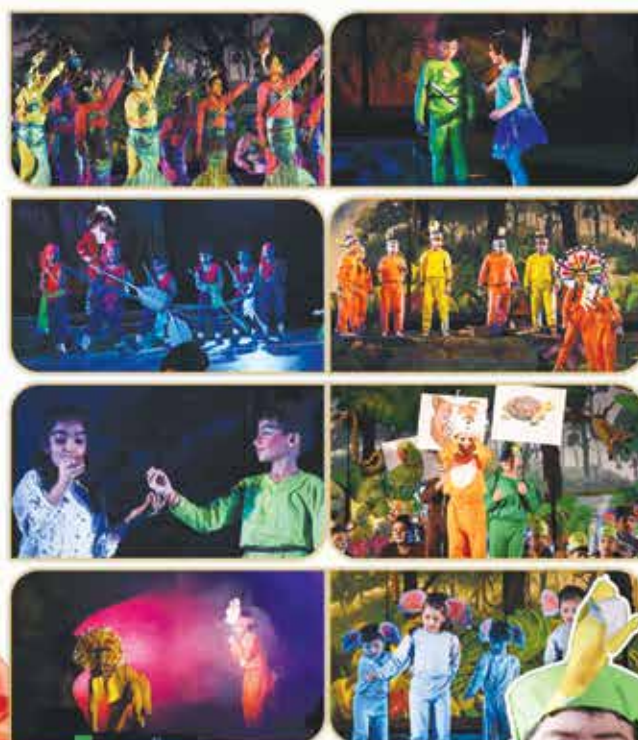
