Proud to state that 'Paving Plus' a project made by the students Ranjan Kumar Gupta, 3rd Year B.Tech – Civil Engineering, Anushka Nayak, (Final Year) B.Tech-Electrical Engineering and Upamanyu Chatterjee, (2nd Year) B.Tech-Electrical Engineering, had won the special jury award at Entrepreneurship World Cup 2019 organized on 22nd July at Sikkim, Gangtok. The event was jointly organized by Atal Incubation Centre, Sikkim Manipal Institute of Technology (SMIT), MISK Foundation (Prince Mohammed bin Salman bin Abdulaziz Foundation) and The Global Education & Leadership Foundation (tGELF).

In today's construction and paving industry, the current clay bricks and paver blocks have no elasticity, low compressive strength and are not durable enough. The raw materials and the process used to make them cause soil erosion and pollution. Paving Plus had developed a material from recycled plastic and a few other secret elements which are all locally available, eco-friendly and cheap.

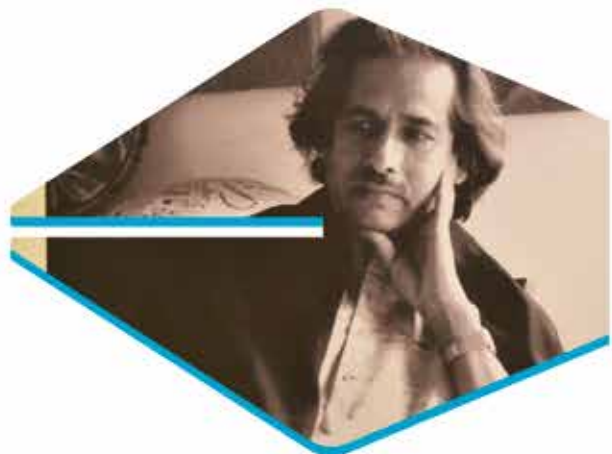

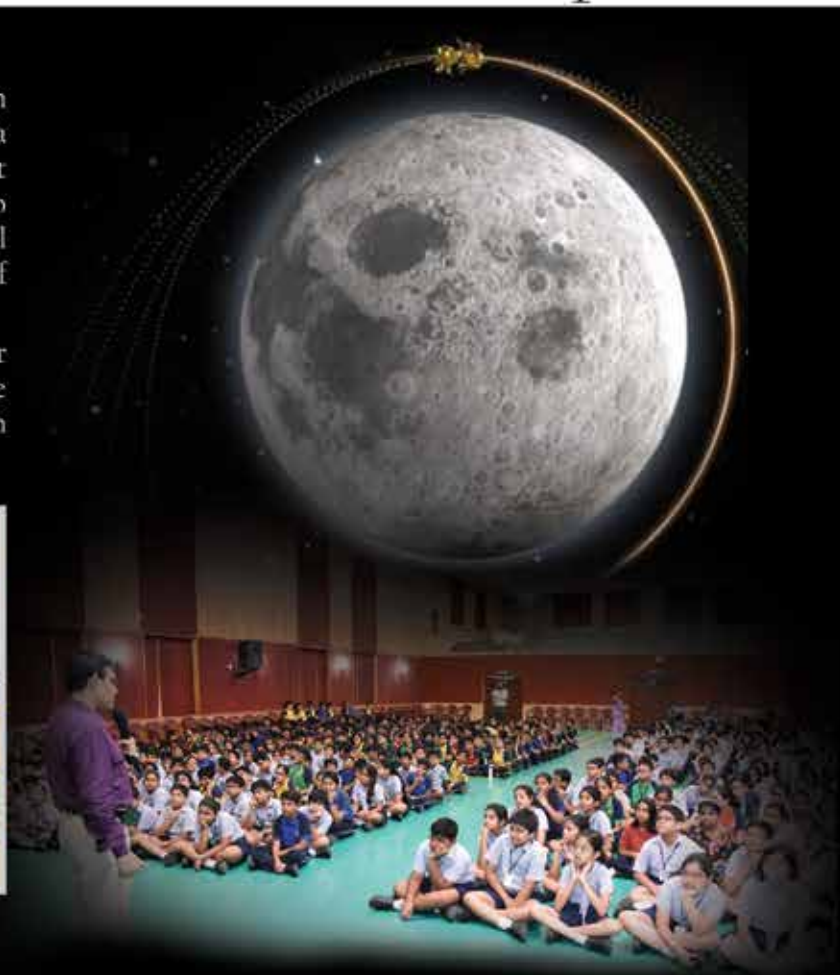
### Chandrayaan 2 - Interaction with THS Students

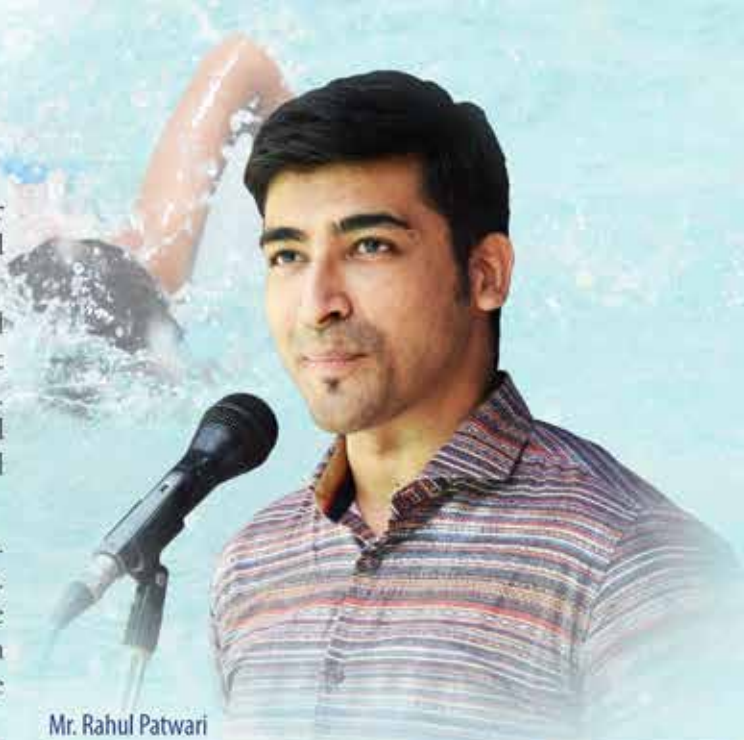


## Swimming Gala 2019

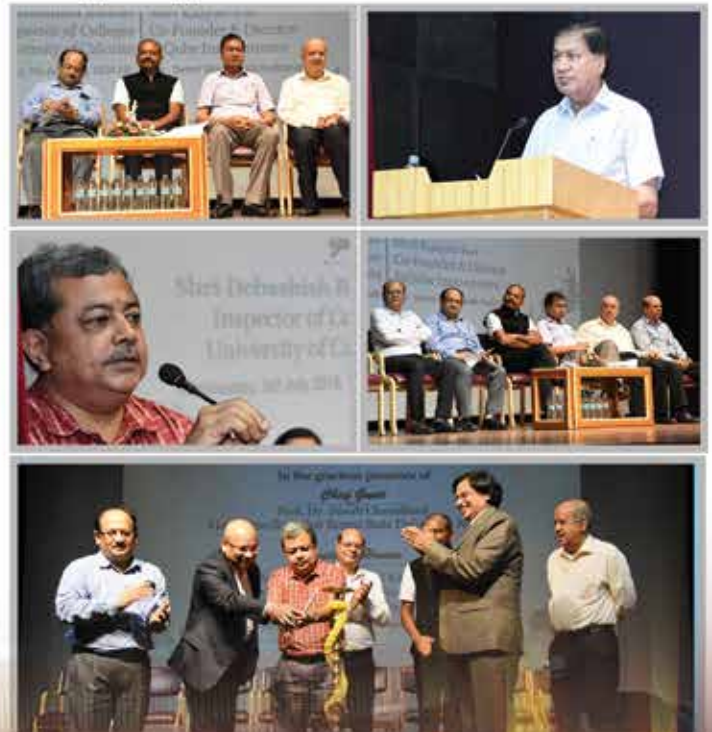

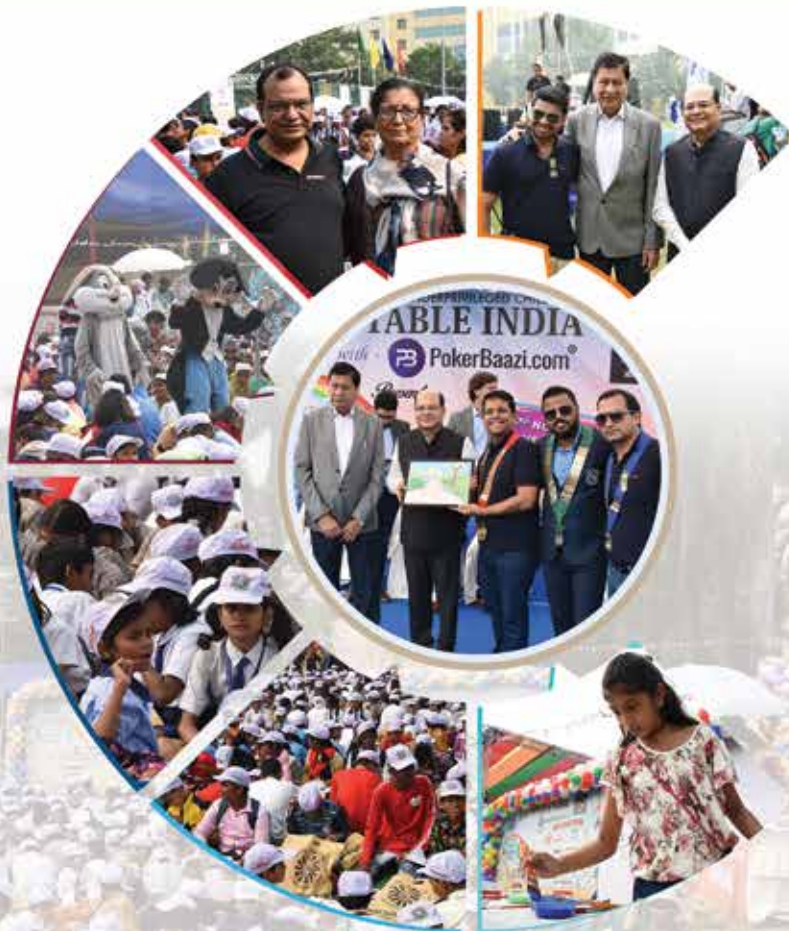
## Round Table India 2019
