INDIA- BULGARIA BILATERAL RELATIONS BUILD THE FUTURE: HER EXCELLENCY MRS. ELEONORA DIMITROVA

Heritage Group of Institutions, Kolkata, organized a talk on 'India-Bulgaria- Opportunities in Higher Education' on 24th November 2021 which was addressed by Her Excellency Mrs. Eleonora Dimitrova, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Bulgaria to India. Her Excellency was accompanied by Mr. Iliya Dekov, Minister Plenipotentiary - Head of Trade and Commercial Section, New Delhi and Shri Vishambhar Saran, Honorary Consul of Bulgaria in Kolkata and also the Trustee of Kalyan Bharti Trust and Chairman, Heritage Law College. 



Over 1.12 lakh participated in the event organised in April end


A total of 1,12,311 persons participated in 'AI for India' initiative organised on April 24 and 25 by Guvi and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).

The event was aimed at up-skilling Indians in Python programming language. The event saw the most number of users taking a programming lesson in 24 hours, beating the previous record by 50 times.

As many as 1.43 lakh users also took part in the online training session to build a face recognition app during the event. Guvi, the AICTE, the Indian Institute of Technology-Madras Research Park and BUDDLA, the clinical and revenue cycle automation platform, conducted the programme. Guvi was incubated in IIT-M Research Park.


WORLD HEALTH DAY 2021


The competition ended with a prize distribution ceremony felicitating the winning teams.




WEBINAR ON '1971: VICTORY OF INDIAN SOLDIERS AND LIBERATION OF BANGLADESH'
