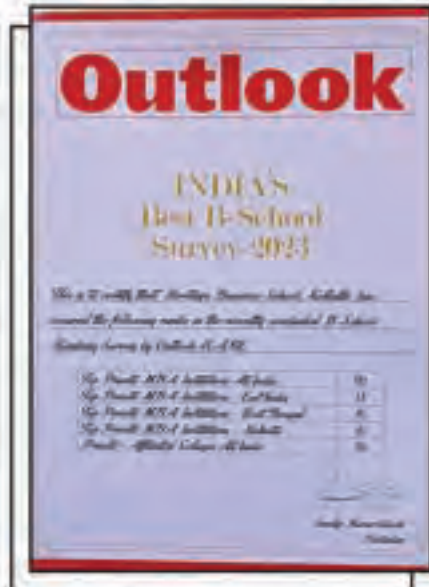

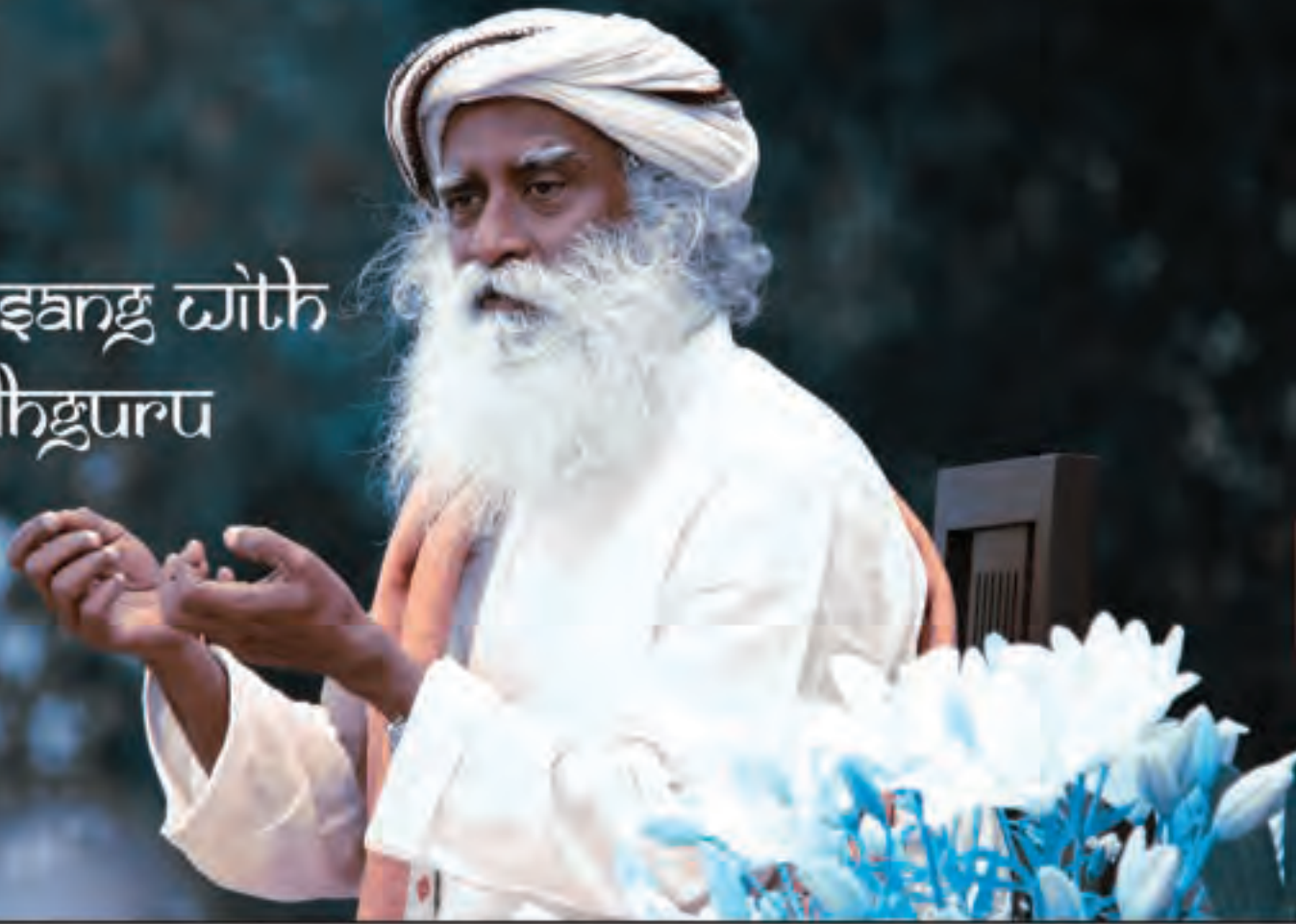
It was organized on 26th September 2022. Cdr. Senthil Kumar from the Indian Navy graced the occasion as the Chief Guest.

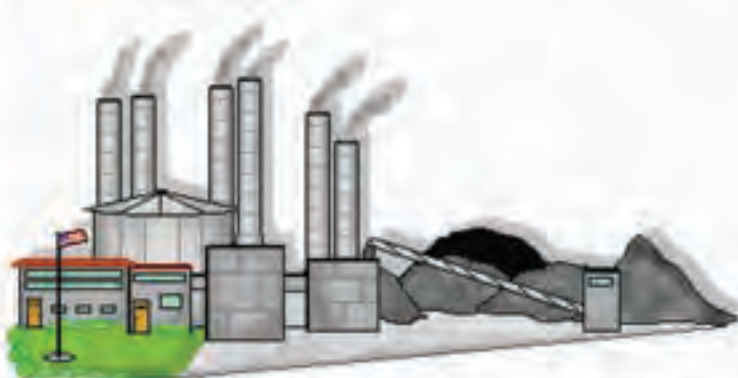
