NOTICE FOR CONTINUING BATCH OF B.TECH, M.TECH AND MCA STUDENTS

The Academic Council of Heritage Institute of Technology, in an urgent meeting held online on 08.09.2020, decided on the evaluation scheme for Even Semester of Academic Year 2019-2020 for continuing batch of B.Tech, M.Tech and MCA students as an exception due to the pandemic situation that affected the normal academic activities and student attendance during the Even Semester 2020. The revised evaluation scheme provided below will replace the evaluation scheme circulated earlier vide Ref: HRIT/0914/3217 dated 30.06.2020.

- 1.1 Assessment of all **theory** papers for (i) 1st, 2nd and 3rd year B.Tech, (ii) 1st year M.Tech, and (ii) 1st and 2nd year MCA students will be done as follows:
 - (a) 30% weightage on the basis of class test/internal assignments and quizzes, attendance etc., as applicable, before lockdown,
 - (b) 40% weightage on End-Semester home assignment based evaluation, and
 - (c) 30% weightage on End-Semester online comprehensive Oral Examination.
- 1.2 Assessment of **sessional/laboratory** papers for (i) 1st, 2nd and 3rd year B.Tech students, (ii) 1st year M.Tech, and (iii) 1st and 2nd year MCA students will be done as follows:
 - (a) 70% weightage on the basis of continuous assessment before lockdown, and
 - (b) 30% weightage on End-Semester online comprehensive Oral Examination.
- 1.3 For **backlog theory** papers of (i) 2nd and 4th Semester B.Tech, and (ii) 2nd Semester MCA, assessment will be done as stated in (1.1) above as students will miss the opportunity of appearing in supplementary examination due to the current pandemic situation.

- 1.4 For **backlog sessional/laboratory** papers of (i) 2nd and 4th Semester B.Tech, and (ii) 2nd Semester MCA, assessment will be done as stated in **(1.2)** above as students will miss the opportunity of appearing in supplementary examination due to the current pandemic situation.
- 1.5 For 1st year B.Tech, M.Tech and MCA students, assessment of all **backlog theory** papers of 1st Semester will be done as stated in **(1.1)** above as students will miss the opportunity of appearing in special supplementary examination due to the current pandemic situation.
- 1.6 For 1st year B.Tech, M.Tech and MCA students having **backlog in sessional/laboratory** papers of 1st Semester must appear in regular examinations at the time of End-Semester examination of Odd Semester of the Academic Year 2020-2021 as per rules of the special supplementary examination.
- 1.7 For students other than 1st year having **backlog in theory/sessional/laboratory** papers of (i) 1st, 3rd and 5th Semester B.Tech, and (ii) 3rd Semester MCA must appear in regular examinations at the time of End-Semester examination of Odd Semester of the Academic Year 2020-2021.

2. ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL STUDENTS:

- 2.1 If any student is willing to apply for improvement of grade in a paper already passed in one of the previous Semesters, as per examination rules of the Institute, he/she may do so and in such a case he/she will be required to sit in the regular examination to be conducted only after the pandemic situation normalizes and the Institute reopens for students.
- 2.2 **If any student is not satisfied with the results, he/she may apply for improvement and may exercise the option of foregoing this result and appear for regular method of examination, which may be held only after the pandemic situation normalizes. In such a situation, the student has to appear in all the theory and sessional/laboratory papers in that semester as well as all relevant backlog papers, if any, on reopening of the institute and results obtained in such regular examination will replace the earlier ones with no option of reverting back. The option should be exercised within seven (7) days of publication of results and an undertaking in this respect will be required to be submitted by such students to the Office of the Controller of Examinations.**
