Agenda Item No. 4: To consider a report on various activities of the Institute since the last meeting

The BOG noted the following:

- 4.1 NIRF 2019 Ranking Heritage Institute of Technology has been ranked 150 amongst Engineering Universities and Institutes (considering both Government and Private) in the country.
- 4.2 AICTE Application for the Academic Year 2019-2020 submitted for
 - (i) Extension of Approval (EOA) of all existing B.Tech. and M.Tech. programmes of HITK
 - (ii) EOA of MCA programme of CAC, HITK
 - (iii) Merging of Computer Application Centre, Heritage Institute of Technology with Heritage Institute of Technology under Merger of Institution under the same Trust operating in the same Campus as per provision of AICTE Approval Process Handbook 2019-2020

AICTE vide its letter no. F.No. Eastern/1-4266792831/2019/EOA dated 30.04.2019 has approved the proposal for merger of Computer Application Centre, Heritage Institute of Technology (Child Institute) with Heritage Institute of Technology (Parent Institute).

AICTE also issued EOA letter for all existing B.Tech. and M.Tech. courses for the AY 2019-2020.

As per approval of merger of Computer Application Centre, Heritage Institute of Technology with Heritage Institute of Technology, with effect from 1st July 2019, Computer Application Centre, HIT is renamed as the Department of Computer Applications being the tenth degree awarding department of Heritage Institute of Technology.

- 4.3 NBA Accreditation: A new application has been created with a Temporary Id 3693-30/04/2019 for accreditation of B.Tech. programme in Mechanical Engineering on NBA Portal
- 4.4 Inspection by MAKAUT, WB: Two members Expert Committee from MAKAUT, WB visited the Institute for inspection of MCA programme and expressed their satisfaction after the visit.
- 4.5 Grant-in-Aid under MODROBS Scheme of AICTE

Department of AEIE received a grant-in-aid under MODROB Scheme of AICTE for the year 2017-2018 with a sanctioned amount of Rs. 14,14,000/- for completion of the Development of the State-of-the-art Industrial Instrumentation Laboratory. Prof.(Dr.) Madhurima Chattopadhyay, HOD, AEIE Dept. is the Coordinator of the Scheme.

- 4.6 Results of Odd Semester Examination November-December 2018 under autonomy
- 4.7 Practical Examinations for the Even Semester 2019 (under Autonomy) commenced from 30.04.2019 to 08.05.2019
- 4.8 Theory Examinations for the Even Semester 2019 (under Autonomy) will commence from 13.05.2019 to 29.05.2019
- 4.9 Micro-Chip Development by HITK under Prestigious India Chip Program (Make in India Initiative): HITK completed 32Kb Memory IP Design of Micro-chip a before schedule for a Product Development Project (Research towards Productization) under Prestigious India Program (Make in India Initiative) in collaboration with eCOE (Electronic Center of Excellence. by ESSCI, Skill India). This scale of integration is first of its kind by any Engineering College in India. Total 8 (eight) HITK students worked in this Memory IP project (7 B.Tech. students in ECE and 1 M.Tech. students in VLSI) under the guidance of Prof. Krishanu Datta, Associate Professor, Dept. of ECE.

- 4.10 First issue of the E-Magazine "AMPERE" of ECE Department published on 28.03.2019. The Bi-Annual magazine publishes recent trends in research, innovative ideas and exposes to the technological advances.
- 4.11 Members of Faculty published 17 papers in various Conferences and Journals during the period under report.
- 4.12 The present status of number of Book Titles (7714), number of Book Volumes (57393) and number of Journals (143) in the Central Library of HITK.
- 4.13 Heritage Utsav 2019 was organized during 01-06.04.2019. In this Utsav 31 (thirty one) technical events during the period 01-03.04.2019 and 33 (thirty three) cultural events during the period 04-06.04.2019 were conducted where students of HIT and other colleges took part.

The students participated in this Utsav with much fanfare and enthusiasm. Members of Faculty & Staff of HITK along with the Faculty Coordinators of 18 (eighteen) different clubs were involved in making Heritage Utsav 2019 a grand success.

- 4.14 Major events like Workshops / Symposium/ Lecture Sessions / Awareness Programme / Programme on Industry Institute Interaction / Inter College Technical Competition held at the Institute during the period under report.
- 4.15 Achievement of students during the period under report:
- ightarrow Mr. Saurabh Suman Yadav, an ECE graduate in 2010 performed brilliantly in IAS Examinations 2019. He ranked 55th in the list.
- → Ms. Sayantika Ghosh, 4th year BT ranked 1st in the All India Rank in the Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) 2019. She got a score of 1000 out of 1000 under Biotechnology stream.
- → Mr. Sayan Mondal, 4th year EE scored 99.14 percentile in the prestigious Joint Entrance Screening Test (JEST) 2019 (Physics) Examination. His All India Rank is 58. Total number of examinee was 13397.
- → Ms. Mayurakshi Mukherjee, 4th year ECE won 1 Silver and 1 Bronze in Asian Indoor Rowing Championships 2019 held in Bangkok during 27-31st March 2019. She was a member of Indian Rowing Team where Team India finished off with a total medal tally of 7 Golds, 5 Silvers and 1 Bronze, finishing at the top of all the Asian countries which took part in the Championship.
