2024 PASSING OUT BATCH STUDENTS

Placements for the 2024 batch have more or less closed, with students having already graduated and left the college.

Of the major IT recruiters, TCS ended strongly with 318 offers over multiple phases. Cappemini, Cognizant and LTI Mindtree also completed their drives, albeit in a limited scale, with a few results still due.

From core industry, Paharpur and Vikram Solar have also just completed their drives, while Schwing Stetter is still in progress.

Overall, 704 students have been placed, out of a batch strength of 1,127, at a placement rate of nearly 70%.
